In addition, recently another 129 Nos. of Model AWCs are sanctioned under NIDA Phase-II. Out of 129 nos. of Model AWCs, 91 nos. of AWCs have been started. The remaining 38 nos. of works will start soon as stated by the DSWO, Barpeta.

The Chairman instructed DSWO, Barpeta to accelerate the pace of construction to complete the construction works of the remaining ongoing Model AWCs early.

Special Nutrition Programme (SNP) Special Nutrition Programme is going on at all the ICDS Projects in the form of Hot Cooked Meals (HCM) and Take-Home Ration.

In FY 2025-26, under Hot Cooked Meal (HCM) programme funds received for 33 days is Rs. 2,47,31,520/- .

In Take Home Ration (THR), rice, white peas, dal, suji halwa, dal khisri and malt based food are being received by ICDS Projects directly from the Directorate of Women and Child Development for 65,505 nos. of children (6 months – 3 years), 13714 nos. of pregnant women, 9403 nos. of lactating mothers during the FY 2025-26.

Various activities under POSHAN Abhiyaan are being conducted at all the ICDS Projects in Barpeta district.

1. Growth Monitoring (Children 0-6 years)
2. Home Visit
3. Pre-School Education
4. Identification of SAM/MAM, Underweight
5. SAM Referral Services to NRC
6. SNP both (HCM & THR)
7. Training to the AWW/AWHs on various indicators.

The fund amounting to Rs. 11,17,000/- for the year 2025-26 has been received, out of which Rs. 5,60,000/- (50.13%) has been utilized as of July 2025.
