**MINUTES OF THE
DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD ON 27-01-2022 AT 10.30 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY
COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, BARPETA**

The list of officers present is enclosed at Annexure -I. The meeting was presided over by Shri Tej Prasad Bhusal, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta.

After the welcome address the meeting reviewed the follow up action in the light of the discussion referring to the minutes of the last meeting held on 21/12/2021.

The fruitfulness of messaging of photographs/videos of public assets & noticing of any anomalies/irregularities of works/schemes in whatsapp number of the District Administration Group was also focused in the meeting. Referring to the discussion of the last meeting, DC once more asked all officers to continue their efforts being a responsible citizen (Action : All Officers)

PHE:- The E.E, PHE, Barpeta Division, Barpeta informed the house that 40456 nos of households have been covered under FHTC against 142120 nos target during the year 2021-22.

The E.E, PHE, Barpeta also informed that about completion of 90 nos of retrofitting of PWSS project under JJM out of 214 nos sanctioned projects.

In a query by the Chairman, regarding progress of running water supply in schools under JJM, The E.E, PHE, Barpeta informed that, 1899 nos have already been completed out of the target of 2135 nos & the remaining 236 nos would be covered soon.

The E.E, PHE, Barpeta informed that the list of Arsenic contaminated water testing reports have not been received from the Inspector of Schools which was discussed in the last DDC meeting for which table top Arsenic filter could not be provided to the schools. The Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta strictly informed the Milan Saikia, DPM, SSA, Barpeta to submit the list within 3 days positively.

Health:- The Joint Director of Health Services, Barpeta informed the Chairman that 2456 nos are positive cases and 27425 nos are found negative cases of covid-19 in the district during the month.

The AEE PWD (B) informed that the DPR for the Const. of the Training Centre proposed out of Aspirational District Fund for Rs. 80.00 lakh have been submitted to DDC, Barpeta. The Chairman instructed to the Jt. Director of Health Services, Barpeta to check Blood pressure and blood glucose for the officers and staff of D.C's office, Barpeta.

The Chairman is instructed to the Jt. Director of Health Services, Barpeta to engage a ANM for survey of the vaccination centre of the rented sub-centre and submit a detail list.

PWD (B):- The AEE, PWD (B), Barpeta Division informed the house that the site selection of 16 nos of Const. of chain of Hostel for working Men & Women at Baghbar LAC under Signature project out of 20 nos are final the const. of 4 nos are going on out of 16 nos Total cost of the works is 50.00 lakh each.

In a query by the Chairman regarding progress of Baghbar Model Degree College, the AEE, PWD (B), Barpeta informed that due to problem of earth filling the work could not be completed. The Chairman instructed to the A.E.E, PWD (B) to contact with DRDA, Barpeta for problem of the earth filling and solve the matter immediately.

The Chairman instructed to the AEE PWD (B), Barpeta to hold a meeting with the contractors regarding slow progress of the scheme immediately and record a minutes and the same to D.C, Barpeta.

PWD (R):- The Chairman instructed the Circle Officer, Kalgachia Rev. Circle to furnish a report on the erosion of Jania road by the river Beki stating the present status & the damage it is likely to create if not attended.

Tourism:- The Chairman discuss about the Tourist point. The DFO, S/F has proposed a view point at Baghbar and the Chairman has approved the proposal of the view point of Baghbar. The Chairman instructed Tourist Information Officer to submit a write up on basic view point and a signature view point immediately.

The Chairman also instructed to the Tourist Information Officer to create the template mentioning the History of the Satras/Namghars. The Chairman also instructed to the Tourist Information Officer, Barpeta to open a district website in consultation with District NIC, Barpeta.

A.II & Vety:- The Chairman instructed to the DVO, Barpeta to engage the field level officer for field visit and submit a report accordingly. The DVO, Barpeta informed the Chairman that the FMD vaccination under NADCP was started but as per instruction of Central Govt., the FMD vaccination was stopped as the quality of vaccine was not in mutation. After getting instruction from the Central Govt. it will be resumed. The Chairman also instructed to the DVO, Barpeta to submit a detail list of FMD vaccination under NADCP for onward submission to the Govt.

Soil:- In a query by the Chairman regarding progress of various schemes the D.O, Soil Conservation, Barpeta informed that the schemes going on under SOPD-GA and RIDF have already been completed. No fund has been received for the new generation schemes till date. The work will be started after getting the New-generation scheme. The Chairman instructed to the D.O, Soil Conservation, Barpeta to visit the Tourist Spot near Nakhanda River & submit a report accordingly. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed the D.O, Soil Conservation to inspect the erosion of Nakhana River with the help of W.R. deptt. immediately.

Tax:- The Superintendent of Taxes, Barpeta informed the house that a family is occupying the land of Tax deptt. The Chairman instructed to the C.O, Barpeta Revenue Circle to take necessary steps in this regards.

Labour:- The Labour Officer, Barpeta informed the house that a total 431469 nos have been registered of unorganized workers on the e-SHRAM portal, out of the target of 5,55,000 nos have been registered through CSC and 230956 nos have been registered by self and 183 nos have been registered through SSK.

Fishery:- The DFDO, Barpeta informed the house that, a list of proposal for 72 nos of ponds under RIAS for 2020-2021 have been submitted to the Govt. for approval.

Irrigation:- In a query by the Chairman regarding progress of the schemes under PMKSY-HKCP (phase-I), the E.E, STD (Irrigation) Sorbhog informed the Chairman that the work order for the non-functioning Solar 55 nos points has been cancelled by the CE (MI). The balance work statement has been submitted to the higher authority for further instruction. The allotment order for the works has been awaited.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
