MINUTES OF
DISTRICT LEVEL COMMITTEE ON AXOM ADARXO GRAM YOJANA (AAGY)
HELD ON 06-11-2020 AT 11-00 AM
IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE
BARPETA

1. The list of members present is enclosed at Annexure-I
2. Due to pre engagement with some officials obligations, the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta could not make it convenient to attend the meeting & the same was presided over by Sri Santana Bora, ACS, District Development Commissioner (I/C), Barpeta
3. At the outset, the Chairperson welcomed all the members of the Committee & the participating officers .
4. Initiating the discussion, DDC (I/C), Barpeta briefly apprised the house about the objective of the meeting. She informed that conceived on the lines of Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana, the Axom Adarxo Gram Yojana will help develop physical and institutional infrastructure in terms of quality public services. Under the scheme, two model villages have already been identified in every constituency. The State government will provide Rs 5 crore to each village for the purpose & for smooth and effective execution of development works in the selected villages a District-Level Committee has been constituted under AAGY in Barpeta district in pursuance of the revised guidelines under AAGY.
The Chairperson stated a total of 16 villages have been identified covering all 8 LACs in the district under AAGY & these are-
5. As per directions from the chair, the Sr. Planning Officer, Barpeta briefly apprised the house about the methodology of implementation of schemes under AAGY & read out some of the important points of the guidelines .
SPO stated that the aim of the scheme is not only the infrastructure development but also to empower the villages towards self sustainable development at all level by converging various initiatives aiming to create good social & economic infrastructure with improving standard of living & self sustainable livelihood.
He stated that as per the guideline for starting of the activities a House to House & Village Level Survey is to be conducted in all the identified villages but the same could not be initiated in due course of time owing to the panemic situation for Covid-19. However, the aforesaid survey would be carried out shortly with close coordination of all the departments concerned to enable preparation of a Village Development Plan (VDP) to meet the objective & requirement of the villages.
SPO stated that with a view to carry out some of the activities which need immediate intervention; Govt in T & D Deptt has already released Rs. 50.00 Lakh per village during 2018-19 under AAGY for which list of project proposals have been received from each of the Village Level Committees against all 16 villages with recommendation for GP concerned in conformity with the guidelines & the same have been placed before the august body for discussion & approval etc.
6. Participating in the discussion, MLA, Baghbar informed that in order to fulfill all the basic requirements of a village a sensitization programme among the villagers is essential to make aware about the scheme. He requested the District Administration to take necessary steps after the Covid-19 pandemic situation is over. He also requested all concerned sectoral heads to initiate visit of the villages to assess the actual needs at the grass root level together with all concerned Public

Representatives & stakeholders & extend cooperation in preparation of a holistic Village Development Plan (VDP).

7. The DLC after threadbare discussion conveyed approval of the entire project proposal as recommended by the VLCs which were prepared based on the standardized cost derived by the State.
8. The MLAs of Barpeta, Patacharkuchi, Bhawanipur also expressed their views on proper & timely implementation of the schemes proposed as the Initial Activities to be carried out of the 1st installment of fund amounting to Rs. 50.00 Lakh under AAGY.
9. During the course of the meeting; all the MLAs made several observations & issued certain directives to streamline & increase efficacy of implementation.
10. The DDC(I/C). Barpeta cum Chairperson stated that the 'Village Development Plan' (VDP) will be based on the data collected as part of the Need Assessment exercise. He requested all the officers as well as the members of Village Level Committee to expedite completion of House to House Survey & Village Level Survey to ensure proper & real incorporation of data for all round development of the selected villages.
11. The meeting ended with a Vote of Tahnks from the Chair.

Minutes of the meeting of the Construction Committee constituted for the purpose of procurement & implementation of some Schemes under AAGY held on 29/06/2021 In the office chamber of the District Development Commissioner,

The meeting was presided over by Sri Diganta Das, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Barpeta.

The Sr. Planning Officer briefly apprised the house about the objective of the meeting. He informed that to ensure the speedy implementation with the uniformity on the rates of different procurement nature of items, the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta vide notification No. BDD-592/2018/AAGY/Pt.IX/2-3 Dtd. 05/06/2021 Constituted a Constn. Committee for implementation of certain schemes, namely, i) Installation of Solar Street Light, ii) Installation of Tara Hand Pump, iii) Installation of Hand Tube Well, iv) Providing water filter. Scheme wise details of discussions are as follows

- 1) **Regarding installation of Solar Street Light:** The meeting discussed on the matter of installation of Solar Street Lights at different villages and noticed that different villages have proposed different unit cost of the solar street light.
 - a) The Sr Planning Officer placed the rates of Solar Street Light as procured by the P&RD Deptt. as per guideline under 15th Finance Commission wherein unit cost of street light was shown as 53,900/- (Annexure A).
 - b) He also placed the rate of Solar Street Light as supplied out of the fund under MPLADs wherein unit cost was Rs 22,687/- (Annexure B).
 - c) Sri Dulu Barman, AGM, APDCL and a member of the committee suggested that the committee may procure the items from the empanelled firm of APDCL at specification & rates of Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) communicated vide Order No. 318/38/2018-GCRT dated 25/06/2020. He also placed the above mentioned MNRE order in the meeting. He suggested that considering climate factors like sunlight, humidity, rain etc in Barpeta district the following specification of solar street light will be appropriate.

Solar Street Light with 75 Wp solar panel, 12W LED luminaire and 12.8-30 Ah Li battery as per MNRE specifications. Benchmark Costs of Rs. 21,340/- (per system) which will include delivery, installation, operationalisation and warranty for replacement in case of any defect for a period of 5(five) years.

- d) The opinion of Sri Dhrubajyoti Sharma, Finance & Accounts Officer, DC's Office and a member of the committee was sought regarding the applicability of the rate of MNRE in the present proposed purchase. On this he expressed his opinion that the benchmark rates of the Govt of India in the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, can be adopted as the maximum rate for this present exercise and this rate should not be exceeded in any circumstance.

All the members after threadbare discussion agreed to the technical specifications proposed by Sri Dulu Barman, AGM, APDCL. Based on the suggestion by Sri D Sharma, FAO, the meeting decided to move the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta for approval of the purchase of the solar street lights as per specification and rate of the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Govt of India, communicate vide Order No. 318/38/2018-GCRT dated 25/06/2020, in pursuance of the Para 4 of the Role of the Construction Committee outlined in the Notification vide No BDD.592/2018/AAGY/PtIX/2-3 dt 05/06/2021..

The DDC, Barpeta enquired with the AGM APDCL if the APDCL can implement the scheme. To this the AGM replied that as the APDCL is preoccupied in implementation of various government programme, it will be difficult to implement the present scheme.

Further, it is also decided to have every unit of the solar street light thoroughly checked by the AGM, APDCL with the assistance of technical personnel deputed by APDCL regarding conformity of the MINRE specification, before installation. The members unanimously decided to request the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta to constitute a group of APDCL officials for the purpose.

Further, it is also decided to obtain a certificate from the secretary of the concerned Gaon Panchayat regarding the successful installation and fault free functioning of the solar street light before processing payment to the supplier.

- e) **Regarding Installation of Tara Hand Pump:** It has been seen that the VLC in respect of Noontola village under Sorbhog LAC proposed 10 Nos of Tara Hand Pump at the unit cost of Rs 54,000/-. The Executive Engineer PHE, Barpeta informed that the cost of installation of THP including platform, drain, cockpit etc. comes to Rs 47,600/- as per APHC schedule of rate 2015-16. The committee accordingly agreed with the unit cost of Rs 47,600/- as per the estimate of PHE, subject to the approval of the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta in pursuance of the Para 4 of the Role of the Construction Committee outlined in the Notification vide No BDD.592/2018/AAGY/PtIX/2-3 dt 05/06/2021. The DDC asked the SPO to obtain the list of pin point from the BDO concerned. The chairman enquired with the EE PHE if the deptt can implement the schemes of Tara pump & HTW. To this the EE replied that due to intensive preoccupation of the PHE deptt with JJM, it will be difficult to execute the schemes by his deptt. In view of this, the committee decided to implement the scheme following the established procedure of implementation through Construction Committee.
- f) **Regarding installation of Hand Tube Well:** It has been observed that the VLC's against 4 identified villages has proposed installation of HTW at different unit cost of Rs 10,000/- & Rs. 20,000/- respectively. Due to non uniformity on the rates it will be difficult in the process of procurement and installation. On the other hand EE, PHE has submitted a model plan & estimate with unit cost of Rs 12586/- on the basis of APHE SoR for 2015-16 which include constn. of platform also. The meeting agreed with the proposal submitted by EE, PHE, subject to the approval of the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta in pursuance of the Para 4 of the Role of the Construction Committee outlined in the Notification vide No BDD.592/2018/AAGY/PtIX/2-3 dt 05/06/2021. The DDC asked SPO to gather all the pin points as per the approved unit cost from the concerned BDOs to enable timely implementation of the schemes. The DDC also asked EE, PHE to submit the list of entire villages of Barpeta district with presence of arsenic so that such locations/ pin points are not approved in order to avoid public health hazard.
- g) **Regarding procurement of water filter:** In respect of the water filters, the meeting decided to request the EE, PHE to finalise the specification of good quality water purifying products and it was decided to procure the items by floating of NIT. The DDC asked SPO to obtain the list of beneficiaries from the BDO concerned after finalization of rates of water filter to be supplied.

The Chairman of the committee also asked SPO to open a joint Account in a bank in favour of the President and Member Secretary of the committee and make process for sanction of fund by the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta as 1st installment against the schemes for speedy implementation.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
